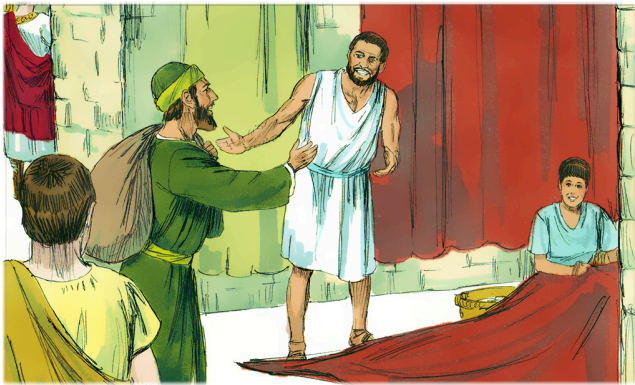


Priscilla & Aquila

Acts 18



Bible Story

Paul's third missionary journey took him from Corinth to Ephesus, and then to many places throughout Asia, including Troas (TROH az). Then Paul went back to Ephesus before heading to Jerusalem.

In Corinth, Paul met a husband and wife—Aquila and Priscilla. They were Jewish tentmakers. Today we're going to look at how Priscilla & Aquila helped spread the good news of Jesus and helped Paul.

MAKE CARDS FOR MISSIONARIES
